Notification on
ICCR Scholarship for Higher Studies in India for A.Y. 2023-2024
(Bachelor/Master & PhD Degree)

It is pleased to state that after the visit of Hon'ble Vice President of India to Cambodia from 11-13 November 2022 to join the 19th ASEAN-India Summit and 17th East Asia Summit in Phnom Penh, the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India has announced to increase the slot of scholarship from 30 to 50 for Cambodian students from the academic year 2023-2024 onwards.

2. Interested and eligible candidates are requested to go through on the Admission to Alumni (A2A) portal: <http://a2ascholarships.iccr.gov.in/> for the information of the scholarship schemes, instructions, list of universities/institutes, guidelines, financial terms, and so on.

3. **The eligibility and criteria**

- (a) Applicants have the option to apply upto 5 Universities / Institutes in order of their preference of study.
- (b) A 500-word essay in English shall be written by the students for checking English proficiency.
- (c) The students can also submit their TOFEL / IELTS etc. if available.
- (d) The Universities / Institutes may conduct an interview online with the students.
- (e) All these scholarships include return air-fares to **nearest airport and train fare to the place of study, if so required.**
- (f) The students shall be between 18 and 30 years old for Under-Graduate (Bachelor) and Post-Graduate (Master) at the time of admission in Indian Universities / Institutes.
- (g) PhD students can be upto 45 years old.
- (h) The scholarship, admissions in Medical / Paramedical (Nursing / Physiotherapy / anaesthesia etc.) / fashion / law courses / integrated courses such as BALLB (5 years) / B.Sc & M.Sc (5 years) etc. are not admissible.
- (i) It is compulsory for all scholarship students to procure Medical Insurance policy with minimum sum assured for Indian Rupees Five Lakhs (approx. \$6000/-) per annum.

- (j) The cost of Medical Insurance will be borne by the students. The **A2A Portal** has two insurance companies for referral.
- (k) For the security of the foreign students, scholarship awardees are advised to stay in the campus hostel, if available.
- (l) The students are allowed to stay in private accommodation if the concerned institute does not insist on staying in their hostel.

4. **Required Documents**

- For BE / B.Tech courses, Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (PCM) are compulsory in 10, 11 and 12 grades of school and it is a mandatory requirement for Engineering courses.
- Mark sheets for each i.e. level 10, 11 and 10+2 equivalent level of school including character / migration certificate should be uploaded alongwith the transcripts in English.
- The application will not be considered without English translation of documents if the original documents are not in English.
- It may also be noted that incomplete application can be summarily rejected by Universities.
- Applicants must have a valid passport, issued by the relevant authorities.
- For Post-Graduate programs, 10+2 certificate, transcript of Under-Graduate's mark sheets alongwith Bachelor Degree are required to be uploaded.
- For PhD program, 10+2 certificate, transcript of Under-Graduate's mark sheets and Bachelor Degree, transcript of Post-Graduate's mark sheet and Degree and Synopsis (Research proposal) to be uploaded.
