Relaxation on Visa & Travel restrictions for Foreign Tourists

With the significant improvement in COVID-19 situation in the country, the Government of India has decided to ease restrictions on visa for foreign tourist as follows:

- i. All foreign nationals intending to visit India for tourism purposes will be allowed to enter into India on e-Tourist Visa/Tourist Visa through Chartered Flights (for group tourism only) from **October 15, 2021**; and
- ii. All individual foreign national intending to visit India for tourism purposes will be allowed to enter into India on e-Tourist visa/Tourist Visa w.e.f. **15.11.2021**.
- 2. All foreign nationals intending to travel to India for tourism purposes are required to obtain a **fresh Tourist Visa** because the existing valid Tourist Visa (in case any foreign national is holding) continues to remain **suspended**.
- 3. Foreign nationals would be permitted to enter India by water routes or by flights, including those under Vande Bharat Mission or Air Bubble Scheme or by any scheduled commercial flights as allowed by the Ministry of Civil Aviation.
- 4. All due protocols and norms relating to COVID-19 as notified by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare shall be adhered to by the foreign tourists.
