# Embassy of India Phnom Penh

Embassy of India, Phnom Penh is pleased to invite applications from foreign students for admissions in B.E./ B.Tech./B.Arch./ B. Pharmacy/ MBBS/BDS and Diploma in Engineering and Diploma in Pharmacy courses in Indian colleges under the <u>Self-Financing</u> <u>Scheme</u> for foreign students of the Government of India for the academic year 2024-2025 against reserved seats.

2. It is noted that the candidate are required to appear in National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) conducted by NTA for admission in MBBS/BDS courses in India.

#### 3. It may also please be noted that the above seats are on a self-financing basis and NO financial aid/scholarship is provided to foreign students selected under the above scheme.

4. The following are the documents to be submitted by the candidate to the Embassy of India, Phnom Penh:-

- > Application form to be filled (Download: <u>Application Form)</u>
- > Three copies of candidate's recent photograph duly attested by the Embassy
- Three attested copies of candidate's certificates and mark sheets with percentage of marks of the qualifying examination and a certificate from Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi that the candidate's qualifying examination is equivalent to 10+2 standard of CBSE in India for the purpose of admission to B.E./ B.Tech./ B.Arch./ B.Pharmacy/ MBBS/ BDS & 10<sup>th</sup> standard of CBSE in India for the purpose of admission in Diploma level technical courses must be enclosed. The website of Association of Indian Universities (<u>https://aiu.ac.in/evaluation.php</u>) may be consulted in this regard.
- > Three attested copies of candidates-
  - First four pages of the passport;
  - Citizenship certificate
  - Birth certificate
  - Character certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended;
  - NEET-UG 2023 Score (For Medical seats)
- Duly filled in application form in triplicate (with authentic English translations, whenever required) may be submitted at the Education Wing of the Embassy of India, Phnom Penh, Tel. 023-210912/13 or mobile. 017710798, no longer than 25<sup>th</sup> June 2024 along with the copies of latest photograph, Citizen certificate, Birth certificate, Character certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended along with academic attainments and other relevant documents in support of the application.

## (A) For MBBS/BDS:

**a)** A candidate must have secured a minimum of 50% aggregate marks with at least 50% in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany & Zoology) separately and 50% in English in the qualifying examination (<u>equivalent to 10+2 standard of CBSE in India – equivalence certificate from AIU, New Delhi must be enclosed).</u>

**b)** NEET – it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50<sup>th</sup> perceptile in NEET.

### (B) For B.E./B.Tech.:-

A candidate must have secured a minimum of 60% aggregate marks with at least 60% in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics separately and 50% in English in the qualifying examination (equivalent to 10+2 standard of CBSE in India – equivalence certificate from AIU, New Delhi must be enclosed).

#### (C) For B. Pharmacy:-

A candidate must have secured a minimum of 60% aggregate marks with at least 60% in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany & Zoology) separately and 50% in English in the qualifying examination (equivalent to 10+2 standard of CBSE in India – equivalence certificate from AIU, New Delhi must be enclosed).

#### (D) For B.Arch .:-

The candidates applying for B.Arch course are required to pass the aptitude Test as prescribed by Council of Architecture. The candidates who do not pass the Aptitude Test will not be eligible for award of enrollment by Council of Architecture, New Delhi.

#### (E) For Diploma in Engineering Courses:-

À candidate must have secured a minimum of 60% aggregate marks with at least 60% in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and 50% in English in 10<sup>th</sup> (equivalence certificate must be enclosed.)

#### (F) Diploma in Pharmacy:-

A candidate must have secured a minimum of 60% aggregate marks with at least 60% in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany & Zoology) and 50% in English in 10<sup>th</sup> (equivalence certificate must be enclosed.)

**(G)** Foreign students can also apply for B.E. / B.Tech. /B.Arch. /B.Pharmacy / MBBS /BDS for nomination with pending final declaration of their qualifying examination results equivalent to 10+2 standard of CBSE.

**(H)** Mere applications should not be treated as assurance for their nomination, all the applications will be scrutinized and only after these are found complete in all respects, the names of the eligible applicants will be considered for nomination on merit and preference of the course.

(I) Selected candidates are expected to comply with admission formalities, fee structure an procedures of the respective colleges/universities. These may include specific medical examinations including Aids test in India.

(J) It may please be noted that the above seats are on self-financing basis and **NO** financial air/scholarship/concession is provided to foreign students selected under above scheme and their fee structure is different from those for Indian nationals.

(K) Last date for receipt of completed applications (in the prescribed proforma) is **25<sup>th</sup> June 2024**.

(L) Blank application forms are enclosed. Only ink-signed copies of the applications with original photographs pasted will be accepted.
