Following important points may please be noted while applying under the ITEC Programme:

- Candidate should have academic qualifications as laid by the Institute for the course
- Candidate should be medically fit and have working knowledge of English
- Candidate should preferably be between the age group of 25 to 45 years
- Candidate should not have availed ITEC training facility earlier.
- Maximum two application forms can be accepted for each course. In case of non-acceptance of application due to large number of applicants for a particular course, applicants are free to apply for another course.

Completed Application Form along with the letter of nomination and other required documents may, thereafter, be sent / submitted to Embassy for further action.
